

How to embed a quiz in a page?

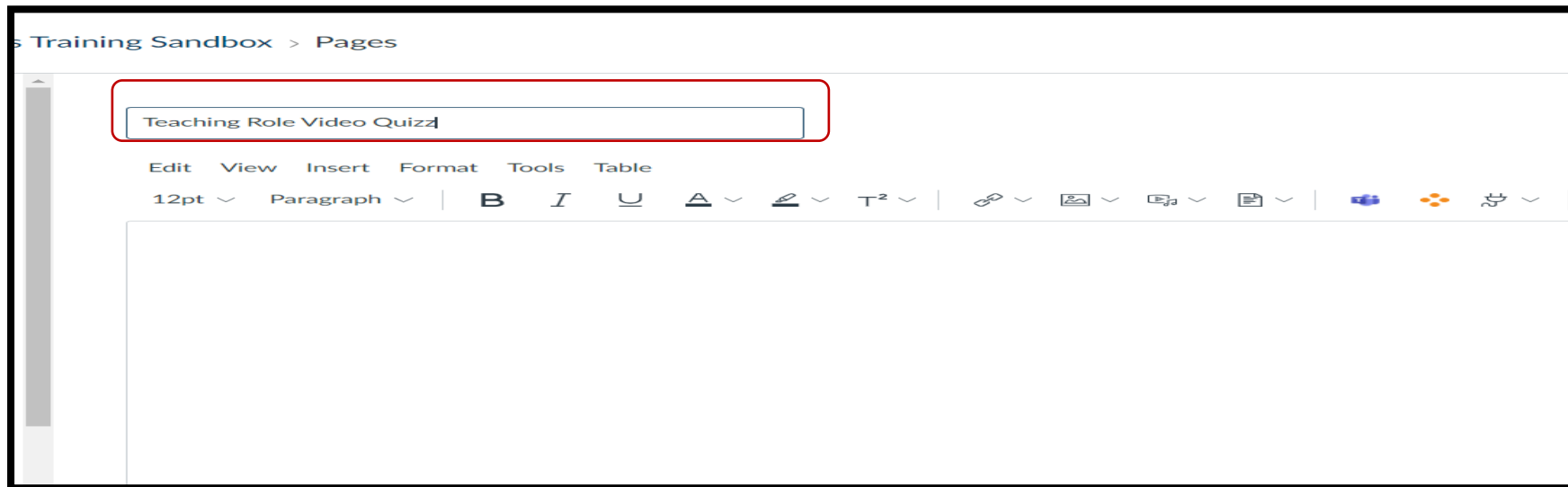
1. Click on your course pages tool.



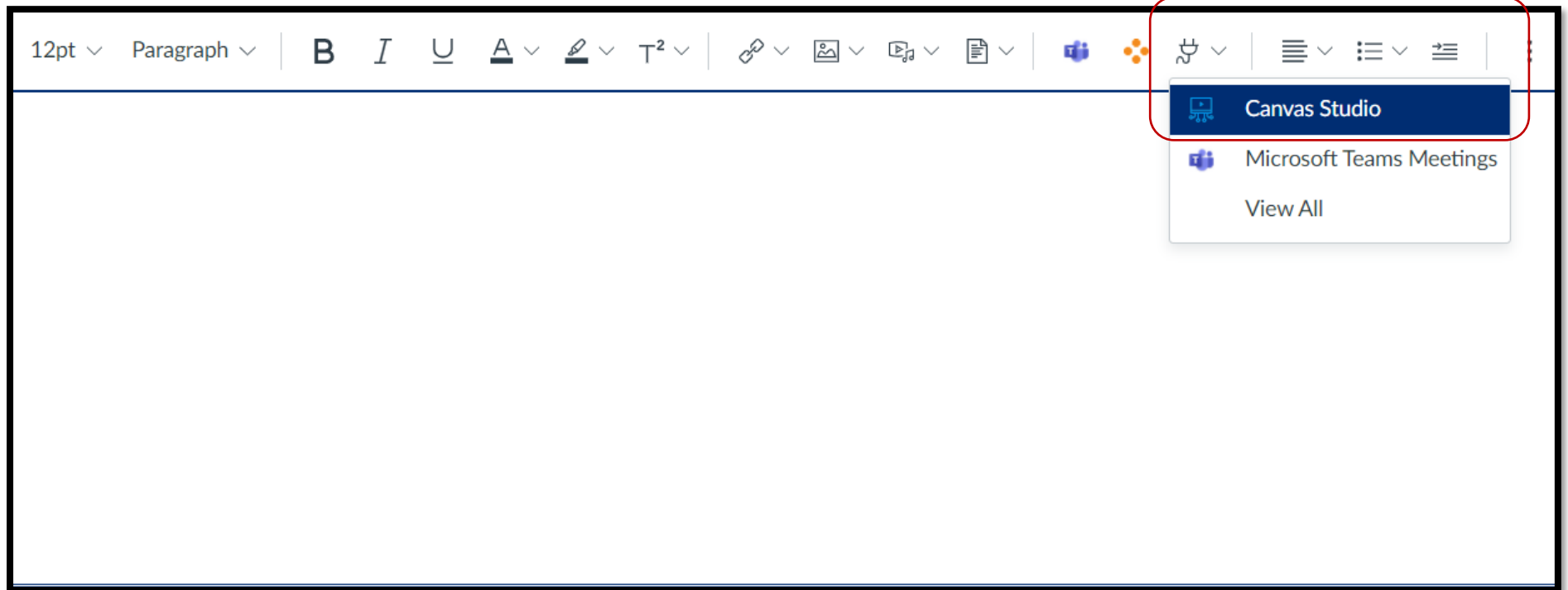
2. Click on Add page .



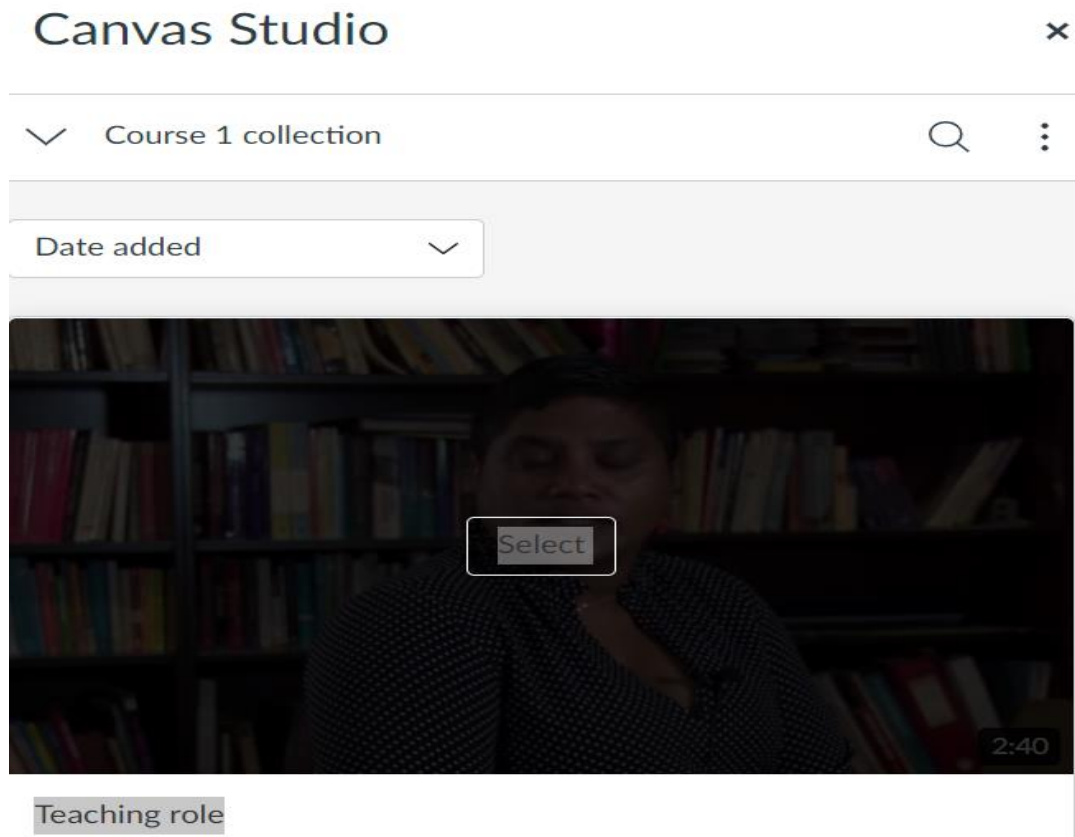
3. Add a title on title text box.



4. Select Canvas Studio on from the plug icon.



5. Click **select**, on the video you choose to embed.

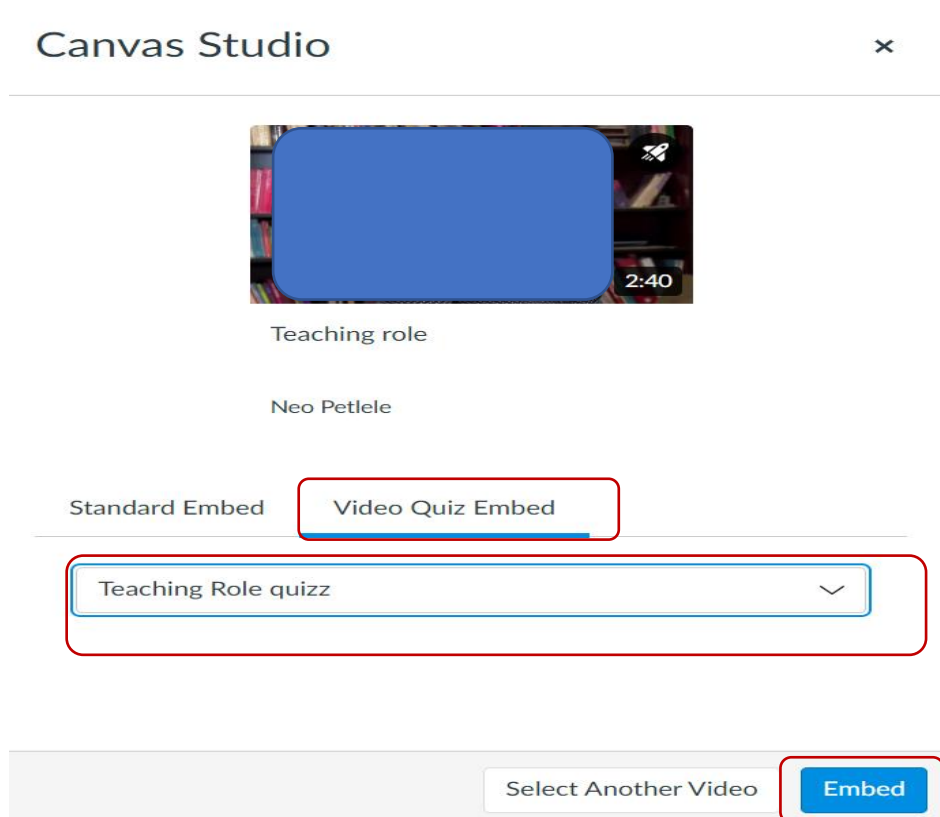
