









## **IMAGE SIZE**

Select Large from the Size dropdown menu in Image Options to ensure that the image is sufficiently visible on both a laptop and a mobile device.



## **DECORATIVE IMAGES**

Some images don't illustrate any of the concepts in your course and don't display information that is part of the course. This means that learners using assistive technology do not need to understand the content of these images to follow the course. Use the option in ulwazi to label these images as 'Decorative Images.'



## **CONTENT IMAGE**

Many images contain information that is part of the course content. For example, maps, graphs, charts, and diagrams. These images contribute to learning outcomes and reflect, clarify, or expand on course content. Learners with visual disabilities rely on 'alternative text' (or ALT text) to access the information in these images. ALT text is a text description of the image that can be read by assistive technology. ALT text should be less than 124 characters and provide a clear description of the image.



## **COMPLEX IMAGES**

Some images carry a lot of information that is only legible when the image is displayed at full size. For example, a global map showing levels of digital literacy in each country. It is often difficult or impossible to narrate the content of these images in a 124 character ALT text. In addition, the information in the image may become illegible when displayed on a mobile device with a smaller screen.

Add a text description of these images under the image so that learners using assistive technology or mobile devices can access the information in these images.
